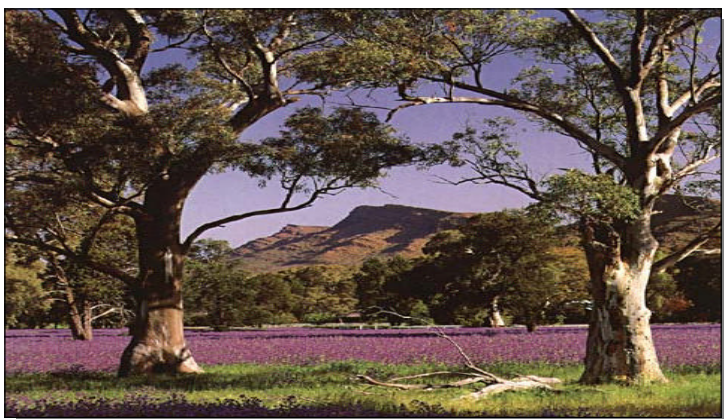

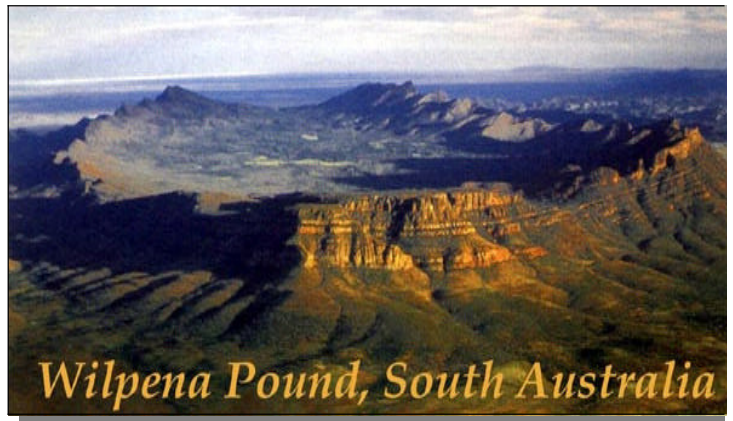
8.00 am. pick up from your Adelaide hotel, travel in the comfort of a modern, air-conditioned 4WD vehicle, 400 Kms. to the North via Pt Augusta to Hawker, the hub of the majestic Flinders Ranges & the gateway to the Outback. Visit the Kanyaka Station ruins, once home to 70 people abandoned due to drought. Lunch at Hawker before continuing our journey to Wilpena Pound Resort, through the beautiful 28 km Moralana Scenic Drive.



Visit the Old Woolshed, Arkaba Sheep Station est. circa 1856, nestled in picturesque country at the foot of the Elder Range, before arriving at Wilpena Pound Resort.



See from the air the splendor of this ancient geological formation one of the oldest in Australia. After your unforgettable 30 minute scenic flight, walk into the Pound and climb Wangara Lookout (optional).



Day two we continue our journey to Arkaroola Wilderness Sanctuary as we travel through the heart of



the Flinders Ranges via Bunyeroo Valley & Gorge,



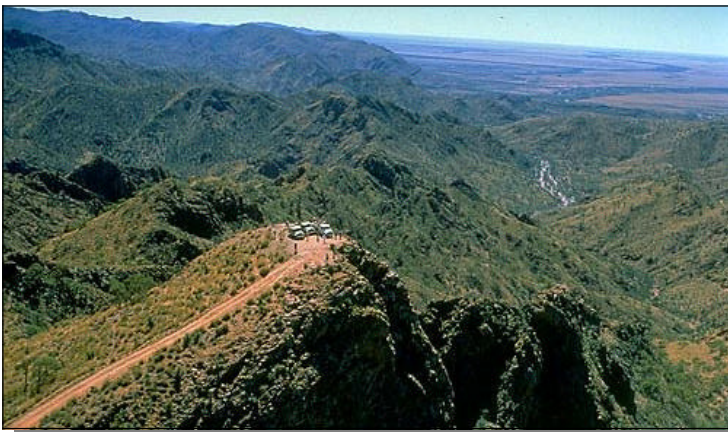
Enjoy morning tea in the Aroona Valley, the area that inspired the famous South Australian artist Sir Hans Heysen. The Heysen Range towers over the Valley.



Travel on through Parachilna Gorge, the old copper mining town of Blinman and 4WD trek into Mt Chambers Gorge for lunch in idyllic surroundings.

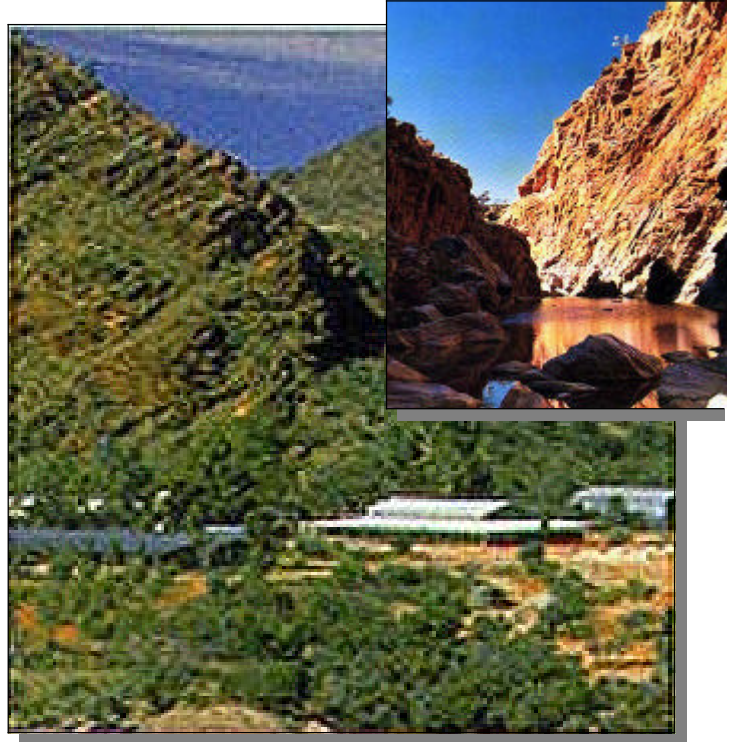


Take a swim in the waterhole before a short hike into a canyon to view the gallery of Aboriginal rock engravings, reputed to be thousands of years old. With an abundance of wildlife in the area you could see Kangaroos, Emus & the graceful Wedge Tailed Eagle.

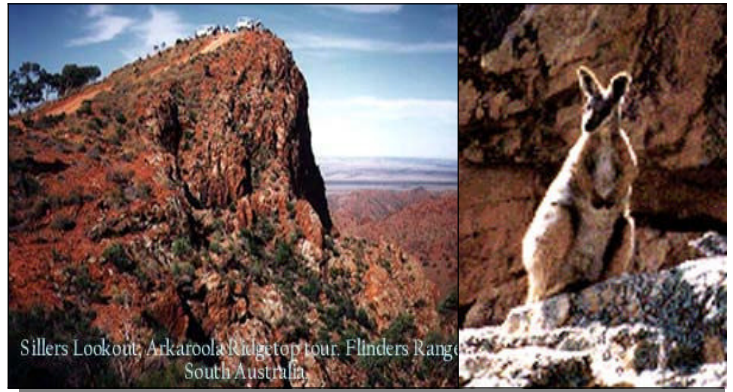


Pass through remote sheep grazing properties & the beautiful Gammon Ranges National Park before arriving at Arkaroola Wilderness Sanctuary

Enjoy the next two nights at the Arkaroola Village Resort, in a tranquil setting in the ancient Gammon Ranges, a geologists playground.



Day three, take the world famous Arkaroola Ridge Top 4WD Tour through the creek beds, valleys and ridges of the Arkaroola Wilderness Sanctuary, the home of the Yellow Footed Rock Wallaby.



Day four, return to Adelaide via Copley and Leigh Creek, travel south along the length of the Flinders Ranges to Hawker, on to Orroroo, Jamestown and the Clare Valley famous for quality wine production. Stop for wine tasting, if time permits, returning to your Adelaide hotel approx 6.00 pm.
