Join The Flinders Ranges Caravan Park 4WD Tour, and spend an enjoyable afternoon traveling through valleys and over ridge tops, in some of the most picturesque country of the Flinders Ranges. The area is abundant with Kangaroos, Wedge tailed Eagles, Emus and wildflowers.



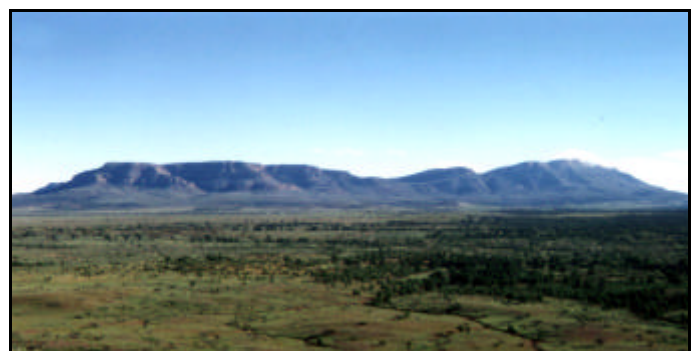
This unique local tour is conducted through the Bunbinyuna Range or the beautiful Arkaba Hills, depending on conditions on the day.



Visit the Old Woolshed, Arkaba Sheep Station, as we travel on to Wilpena Pound Resort.



Chace Range viewed from Pugilist Hill Lookout. Once an ancient mountain 3,000 metres high.



Wilpena Pound viewed from Pugilist Hill Lookout. See the effects of 160 million years of erosion.

Enjoy a 30 minute Scenic Flight around this spectacular geological formation and marvel at the forces that created it.

Formed from undersea sedimentary deposits 640 million years ago, folded into mountains as high as the Andes, and eroded over 160 million years.



Travel through Bunyeroo Valley, Bunyeroo Gorge and Brachina Gorge, a geological journey through 640 million years.

Day two of our “Flinders Explorer” three day tour takes us on a day trip, 140 Kms to the northeast of Wilpena, through outback sheep grazing country to Mt Chambers and the Chambers Creek Gorge, one of the most spectacular accessible Gorges in the Flinders Ranges.



4WD trek into Chambers Gorge, swim in a water-hole, and enjoy a picnic lunch in idyllic surroundings before viewing the gallery of aboriginal rock engravings reputed to be 40,000 yrs old.



Pass through Bunyeroo and Brachina Gorges, before our return to Adelaide. Visit the Clare Valley famous as a quality wine producing area, where we stop to sample some of the local produce.

Arrive in Adelaide approximately 6.30pm.
